INVITATION FOR MISSION SUPPORT ORGANIZATION TO ATTEND THE ASSOCIATION OF MILITARY CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP'S SOUTHERN AFRICA TABLE MOUNTAIN TOP INTERACTION FROM 16 – 23 NOVEMBER 2023 IN CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA

The Association of Military Christian Fellowship (AMCF) plans to host the Southern Africa Table Mountain Top Interaction, to be held in Cape Town and surrounds from 16 – 23 November 2023.

The event is called the Table Mountain Top Interaction (TMTI), being the vision of the AMCF Southern African region and desiring to give the delegates a truly memorable and lifelong mountain top Christian experience. The TMTI has the approval and blessing of the World AMCF President, General (Ret) Essel Soriano from Philippines.

The Goal of the TMTI is to equip emerging Junior Christian leaders within the armed forces with the skills and experience required to prepare them for ministry and exemplary service where they are located.

The Objectives of the TMTI are as follows:

- Participate in outdoor activities at which delegates' experience physical tests that expand the knowledge of their physical and mental capabilities.
- Provide ministry tools such as basic bible study methods, a story of their spiritual journey and a plan of action for the future.

- Provide leader training that has application for both their profession and ministry.
- Explain external AMCF resources available to help delegates in future activities and planning.
- Introduce the delegates to Southern African National Defence Force Christians in both their professional and domestic settings.
- Experience some of the South African culture and leisure-time activities.
- Interact with other international delegates from the Southern African Development Community (SADC) and the AMCF Africa South region and beyond.

The aim is to enable 20 delegates to attend the TMTI in Cape Town. A programme of events and briefing document will be forwarded to nominated delegates, upon receipt of registration forms confirming attendance.

The SANDF will not financially support the TMTI, being a private initiative of the AMCF. Financial support is being requested from prospective international and local sponsors, both in the AMCF family and privately. Delegates and guests will be required to pay a registration fee of \$30 (USD) on arrival at the Interaction. Accommodation, food, local travel and sightseeing costs for delegates will be paid for by the AMCF, but it would be appreciated if the respective sending MCF's could financially support their national delegates concerning air travel costs to and from the TMTI 2023.

Personal expenses before and after the TMTI dates i.e. outside 16 - 23 November, must be borne by the delegates themselves.

You are respectfully requested to please consider attending TMTI 2023. Nominations should be emailed to the email address above. Closing date for acceptance of nominations is 28 July 2023.
