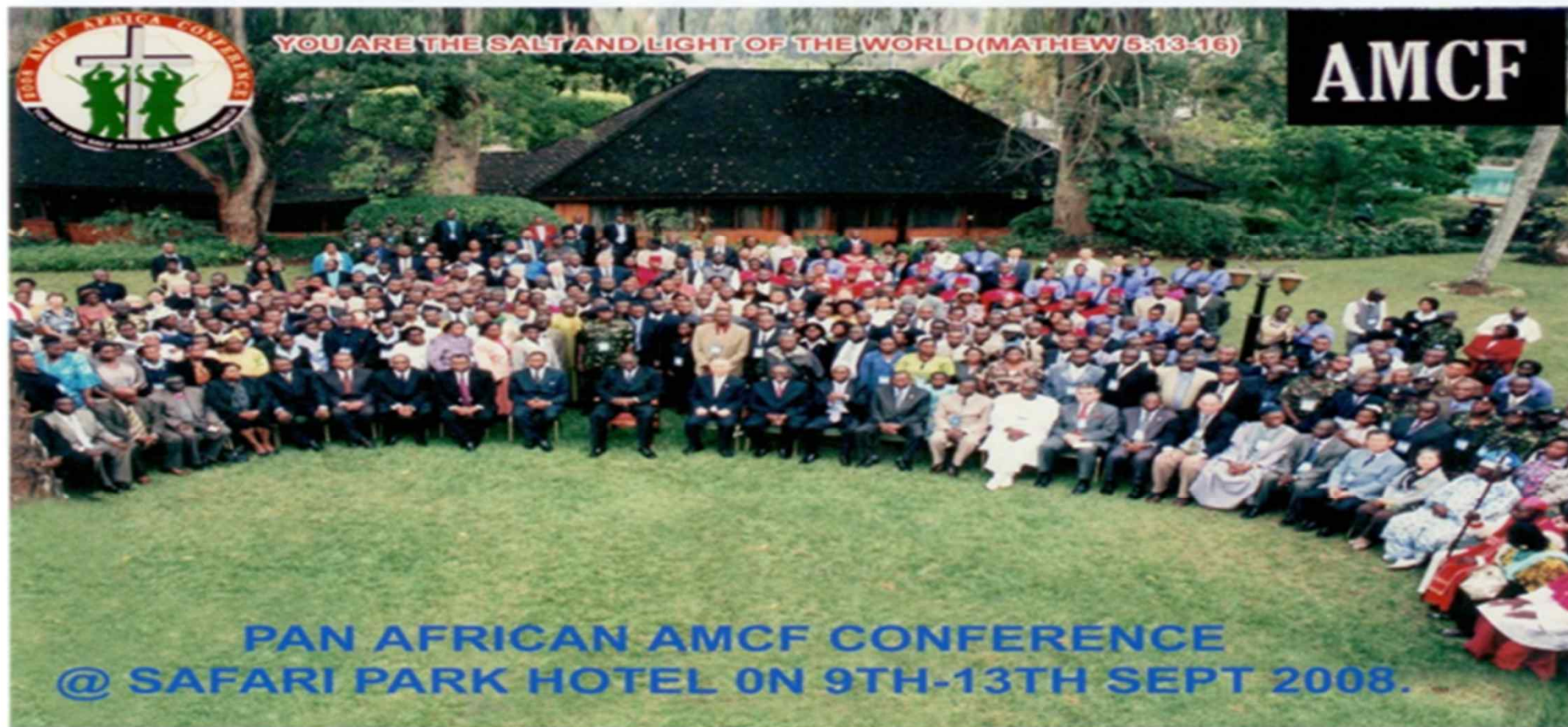

1 2024 Foreign Military Fellowship in Korea (FMF-K) Interaction

The 2024 FMF-K Interaction hosted by MSO was held face-to-face at Jaun Church in Daejeon on June 29th and at Sokcho Chuyanghouse on July 6th and 7th for foreign officers receiving education and training at military schools in Korea such as Korea National Defense University, Korea Defense Language Institute, Army Staff College, Naval War College, and Air University, and their families who wish to participate in the Interaction.

The program for the first day of the Interaction (June 29) included the opening worship service, introductions to national MCFs, AMCF, 3 PSOs and other related organizations, and discipleship training subjects such as Inductive Bible Study (IBS), Conversational Prayer (CP), Military Christian Ethics and Military Christian Leadership.

The second (July 6th) and third day's (July 7th) training was centered on evangelism, including *Jesus Story*, *Personal Testimony*, and *Mom's & Kid's Program*. This interaction
